

My Voting Plan

The purpose of this document is to assist you in preparing your own personal voting plan. The document includes voting details that each person needs to consider so that they may have a successful voting experience.

The details are presented in the form of simple questions. Each person should answer each question based on their own unique circumstances. After answering each question, you will have created your own personal voting plan.

You are encouraged to write your answers in the space provided. Most importantly, after you create your voting plan, be sure to follow through and do each step!

- 1. Who Can Help Me Make My Voting plan?** _____
Name a person (or persons) who you trust, and who you can ask to help you create and follow your voting plan. It can be a family member, a friend, or a staff member.

- 2. Am I registered to vote? Yes or No**

If you are registered, you are done with this question.
If no, here is where you look to see if you are registered, and steps to take to register.

Registration deadline is October 5, 2020

- 3. Have you moved since the last election? Yes or No**
If yes, you need to update your address with the Board of Elections (BOE) and confirm the updated registration with the BOE.
If no, you are done with this question.

- 5. 3 Ways to Vote—Circle the one that is best for you**
 - Absentee or voting by mail
 - Early Voting—Begins Oct. 6 at WC Courthouse. Check website for hours
 - At the polls on Election Day on November 3, 2020 Hours: 6:30 am – 7:30 pm.

- 6. Visit the BOE website and review your sample ballot at any time, and certainly before election day. You can fill it out and take it with you into the voting booth!**

If Voting Absentee or By Mail

Please Note: All registered voters will be sent an absentee ballot application by the Secretary of State.

7. Have I received my absentee ballot application? Yes or No

If yes, you need to complete the application and return it to the BOE.

If no, request one here <https://www.VoteOhio.gov>.

If voting absentee or by mail, absentee ballots will begin being mailed on October 6.

Once you receive your absentee ballot, **carefully** complete it and return it **AS SOON AS YOU CAN!** It must be postmarked by November 2, or delivered to the BOE drop box on or before 7:30 pm on Election Day, Nov. 3.

You can return your absentee ballot by mailing it to the BOE or dropping it off in the Dropbox outside the WC Courthouse entrance (available 24/7).
